
INTRODUCTION


















S O C I E T I E S INTRODUCTION

How to join a society?

Every year the society opens its recruitment process which is announced through Slate emails and advertised throughout the campus. The students have to fill in the forms shared or give walk-in interviews to the current Executive Councils.

How to register a new society?

The registration of a new society is done through One Stop. Students are requested to give a meaningful purpose of creating a new society and find themselves a faculty mentor who is ready to mentor and supervise the society throughout its journey. Once the process is complete the form should be submitted to One Stop for further processing and approval of the Director Campus.

How to organize a society event?

To organize a society event, students are requested to fill in the event form available at One Stop, declaring the purpose, goals, activities, required support, venue, and budgeting. The event form must be signed by the society mentor and then forwarded to the Director of Campus through One Stop for approval.

ISB campus welcomes parents to the campus on any day for students' academic information or record discussion. It is suggested that parents must visit the student's profile on LMS.

DO EMPLOYERS RECRUIT STUDENTS ON CAMPUS?

Our career office actively arranges induction seminars/ recruitment drives from well-known tech organizations. Campus organizes annual job fair events for recruitment of our graduation batch. Therefore, the students are advised to actively respond and attend any such events organized by the Career Services Office.

WHAT SORT OF CLUBS AND SOCIETIES CAN STUDENTS JOIN?

Several societies, covering a wide variety of interests, are available for students to join or attend. Social, sports, and literature-based clubs also exist. The campus also provides you with clubs like ACM and IEEE that bridge academia and industry.

WHAT IS THE SOCIAL LIFE ON CAMPUS?

Campus organizes multiple events annually such as orientation ceremonies, welcome parties for newcomers, recreational tours, technical competitions, sports events, annual leagues, farewells, and much more. FAST Islamabad campus also conducts the biggest three-day annual event NASCON to invite delegations and provide students an opportunity to build networks.



WHAT ARE ALLIED FACILITIES AT CAMPUS?

Computing labs, engineering labs, common rooms, sports grounds, fitness center, medical center, mosque, library, discussion rooms, transportation, and research labs.

1. Attendance requirement

Students are required to maintain 100% attendance in lectures, labs, tutorials, seminars, and discussions as prescribed by the course instructor. The absence of a maximum of 20% of the total lectures may be condoned for genuine reasons, such as illness. Failure to meet attendance requirements will render a student ineligible to appear in the final examination of the concerned course.

2. Academic Warning/ Probation

At the end of every semester (including the summer semester), a warning is issued if the CGPA of a student is less than the minimum required for graduation. Minimum CGPA required to avoid academic warning:

BS/BBA programs 2.00

MS/MBA programs 2.50

Ph.D. programs 3.00

- **A.** A student on academic warning needs the approval of the Head of the Department to register for desired courses.
- **B.** If, after a semester, the CGPA of a student is less than the required minimum, the Warning Count increases by one.
- **C.** If the Warning Count becomes three, admission of the student to the University is closed.
- **D.** If after receiving a warning CGPA improves and equals or exceeds the required minimum, the Warning Count is reset to zero.

3. Semester Registration

Students are required to register in Fall and Spring semesters and to pay the current semester fees. All students are required to register for normal course load, except those on academic warning. The recommended registration procedure is as follows:

- A. Clear all previous fees and dues before registration.
- **B.** First-semester students should register through the Academic Office. All other students should register online.
- C. Pay current dues in full immediately after registration is complete.



4. Registration of students under warning

- A. Must register for all such courses, in which the grade is F or U.
- B. Should register for all such courses in which the grade was D, D+, or C-
- **C.** Should not register for more than five courses.
- **D.** Students with a warning count = 2 MUST not register for a new course.
- **E.** Parents/guardians are called to the campus for a consultative meeting with the HoD.
- **F.** Must obtain written approval from their Head of Department for each course that they register, add, drop, or withdraw.
- **G.** Students studying under scholarships (OSP, HEC, FAST, or others) must take a full load.

5. Withdrawal from a Course

- **A.** Students are not allowed to withdraw from any course in the first two semesters.
- **B.** Withdrawal is not allowed due to a shortage of attendance, unless it is due to reasons beyond one's control, e.g. hospitalization.
- **C.** Application for withdrawal from course(s) must be countersigned by the parent or the guardian of the student.
- E. A request to withdraw from a course requires the approval of the HoD.
- **F.** For courses having an associated lab, withdrawal is always from both the theory and lab portions of the course.
- **D.** Withdrawal requests must be submitted to the Head of Department (HoD), before the last day of classes.
- E. A request to withdraw from a course requires the approval of the HoD.
- **F.** For courses having an associated lab, withdrawal is always from both the theory and lab portions of the course.
- G. The fee is not refunded for a withdrawn course.

6. Transfer of students between campuses

The request of a student for transfer from one campus of the University to another will be considered only on the following grounds:

- A. Death of a parent
- B. Posting of a parent to the city where the transfer is desired.
- C. Marriage of a female student.



The Transfer shall not be considered in the following cases:

- 1. The student is under disciplinary punishment.
- 2. Disciplinary action is pending against the student.
- 3. Dues are outstanding against the student.
- 4. During the course of a semester.
- **E.** A request to withdraw from a course requires the approval of the HoD.
- **F.** For courses having an associated lab, withdrawal is always from both the theory and lab portions of the course.

7. Transfer of students between departments

The request of a student for the transfer from one department to another will be considered on the following grounds:

- **A.** Passing the entry test of that degree program conducted in the Fall semester annually.
- B. The request is made until the 5th semester.
- **C.** All similar courses in both degrees; above grade C will be exempted.

8. Section Change

There are two sections assigned to a student:


- **A.** Parent section: assigned by flex team & to change this section the request is forwarded to the HoD with a valid reason.
- **B.** Course section: assigned by the academic office and can be changed for elective and repeat courses. The core courses are to be taken in the assigned sections and cannot be changed.

9. Sports Equipment

Sports Equipment is available at the Sports Office near Cricket Ground. Students are requested to issue the equipment from there whenever needed and take good care of it until returned.

10. Photocopy

There are two photocopy machines installed in the university for the students. One is right next to the entrance of the café and the other one is situated on the 1st-floor lobby of Electrical Engineering (B-block).


